Ms. Monica Jalota, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

It is stated that the petitioner is working as Inspector in the office of District Controller, Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Gurdaspur. He states that the petitioner is an honest officer and he is being harassed by respondents No.4 to 6 as he has refused to accede to their illegal demands. He has even received threats to his life from the above said respondents. In this regard, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 11.10.2019 (Annexure P-5) to the Police Commissioner, Amritsar (respondent No.3), however, no action thereon has been taken.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or opining the veracity of the allegation contained in the representation, this

petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 11.10.2019 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously in accordance with law.
