This order of mine shall dispose of two regular second appeals
bearing **RSA No.2063 of 2017** titled as **“Bakhshish Kaur V/s Kewal Singh
and others”** and **RSA No.1911 of 2018** titled as **“Kewal Singh V/s
Bakhshish Kaur and others”**.

Both the appeals have arisen out of the common Civil Suit

bearing No.51057 of 2013 titled as “Kewal Singh V/s Paramjit Singh” seeking permanent injunction restraining the defendants from forcible interference and dispossession of the property bearing No.429/12, Krishna Nagar, Near Adarsh Nagar, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the parties submitted that the suit filed by Paramjit Singh, proforma respondent in both the appeal, in respect of same very property, has been decreed on the basis of the compromise (Ex.C1).
