HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the case of the petitioners for the grant of the relief, which has been prayed in the present writ petition, is squarely covered by the decision of this Court in CWP No.28399 of 2013 titled as **Karamjit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have served the respondents with legal notice dated 15th/22nd August 2019 (Annexure P-12) for the grant of the same relief as allowed to the similarly situated persons. Counsel for the petitioners further states that the said legal notice is still under consideration of the respondents and has not been decided so far and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order in view of the law laid down by this Court mentioned above.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15th/22nd August 2019(Annexure P-12) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to them within three months thereafter.
