Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.139 dated 16.09.2019 under Sections 406 & 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 18.10.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the FIR, though it is stated that the complainants had given an amount of Rs.1.60 lacs to the petitioner and the co-accused – Waris Masih but they do not give any details of the alleged payment. It is further submitted that the complainants traveled to Dubai and after spending 15 days, they came back as they could not procure the

work...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
