GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.31, dated 20.5.2017, registered at Women Police Station, Sonapat, under Sections 323, 34, 377, 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Petitioner No.1 Dr.Dilmohan Singh as well as the complainant Sonia (respondent No.2) are present in person. Learned counsel for the petitioners has handed over a draft for an amount of Rs.8 lakhs to the counsel for the complainant who has handed over the same to the complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that upon payment of the aforesaid amount, the entire agreed amount stands paid. It has further been submitted that marriage between the parties already stands dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent.
4. The complainant, who is present in the Court has been identified by ASI Jai Bhagwan, present in the Court. Upon a query made by this Court, she has stated categorically that she has compromised the matter with the petitioners and that pursuant to the said compromise their marriage stands dissolved and that she has received the entire amount as agreed amongst them and that nothing is due and that no claim survives against the petitioners. She has further stated that she has no objection in case the FIR is quashed.
5. In view of the aforestated position where the parties have apparently resolved their issues amicably and have also got the marriage dissolved and that the complainant who is present in the Court has categorically stated before this Court that she has no objection for quashing of the FIR, the petition is accepted and FIR No.31, dated 20.5.2017, registered at Women Police Station, Sonapat, under Sections 323, 34, 377, 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
