Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.599 dated 26.08.2019 registered under Sections 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 3(1) (r) and 3(2) (v) (a) of SC & ST Act at Police Station, Gharaunda, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that police after investigation has found that the allegations with regard to theft and use of firearm are not made out against the petitioner. He points out that offences under Sections 323/427/148/149 IPC are bailable. He further points out that the allegation against the petitioner is that he has abused the first informant who belongs to Scheduled Caste.

The petitioner is in custody since 02.09.2019. Investigations are complete. Final report has been submitted and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
