Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus to appoint a Warrant Officer for release of detainee Neha, minor grand-daughter of petitioner, who is alleged to be in illegal custody of private respondent No.6 since 04.10.2019.

Heard.

The petition is vague, which lacks material particulars such as the parentage and place of residence of the detainee. Even it is not pleaded that the detainee was residing with petitioner. The contents of the petition do not inspire confidence, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking the extra-ordinary jurisdiction.

The petition is dismissed.
