Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.193 dated 01.10.2019 registered under Sections 22, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner who works as a driver with Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, brings intoxicants tablets from Haryana and deliver the same to co-accused Karnail Singh. On such seizure, more than 1000 intoxicants tablets were recovered from Karnail Singh-co accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no recovery from the petitioner. Hence, he submits that petitioner is entitled to pre-arrest bail.

This Court has considered the submissions. However, looking into the gravity of offence and seriousness of allegations made, this Court does not find petitioner to be entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
