The present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to deliver the possession of flat of EWS category in Hansi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the possession has not been handed to the petitioner so far.

The writ of *mandamus* has been sought without moving the authorities concerned as no representation has been filed so far, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation has been filed but that is not a part of writ petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to move a detailed representation to the respondent authorities within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case, such a representation is moved, the respondent authorities is directed to take action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks thereafter.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
