ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for taking stern/strict legal action against accused/respondents No.8 to 10 in FIR No.167 dated 20.10.2013, under Sections 302/364/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no doubt Special Investigating Team was constituted and a cancellation report was submitted, however, the Court of competent jurisdiction did not agree with the aforesaid investigation report and has remitted the matter back to the prosecuting agency for further investigation. He further submits that son of the petitioner was allegedly killed and due to influence, the local police is not properly investigating the matter.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the parties at length. It would not be appropriate for this Court to express any opinion on the merits of the contentions raised. It is suffice to observe that in the facts of the

present case, it is considered appropriate that the further investigation should be carried out under the supervision of a superior police officer i.e. Inspector General (Zonal), Amritsar, who would constitute a Special Investigating Team, consisting of senior police officials under him not posted in District Gurdaspur and get the matter investigated in accordance with the directions issued by the Judicial Magistrate. Since the FIR is already almost 06 years old, therefore, Inspector General (Zonal) is impressed upon to get the investigation completed as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
