Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0283 dated 15.06.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

On 22.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a simpleton villager, involved falsely in FIR No.0283, dated 15.06.2018, registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari. The petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail. Learned counsel further submits that 2 bank officials and the counsel, who prepared search report have already been arrested and released on regular bail. He further points out that number of such cases have been registered against the farmers with similar allegations.

Notice of motion for 31.11.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Bahadur Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 22.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
