On 23.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.19 dated 19.01.2019 registered under Sections 336/506/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (Act No.45 of 1860) and under Section 25 of Arms Act (Act No.54 of 1959) at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury and the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 07.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner

shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

On 07.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his information, petitioner has the joined investigation, correctness whereof is disputed by counsel for the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Tirath Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to join issue on this aspect and the petitioner would once again join investigation, on 14.11.2019, at 10.00 AM.

The Investigating Officer is directed to remain present at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Adjourned to 18.11.2019.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Tirath Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has not come forward to join investigation.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
