RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

[1]. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.09 dated 15.09.2019 registered under Sections 304-B and 498-A IPC (offence under Section 306 IPC has been deleted) at Police Station Jhojhukalan, District Charkhidadri.

[2]. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the FIR was registered on the basis of statement of father of the deceased. Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Renu Kumari on 04.03.2015. It was a love marriage against the wishes of the family members.

[3]. The couple filed CRM-M No.7845 of 2015 in the High Court. Vide order dated 12.03.2015, the representation filed by

the couple before the Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani was ordered to be decided by the Authority by looking into the grievance of the couple and if required, necessary protection was to be given to them, if they were not found involved in any other unlawful activity.

[4]. Thereafter, the FIR was registered with the allegations of maltreatment and demand of dowry by the petitioner and the victim committed suicide due to said harassment. The first anticipatory bail i.e. CRM-M No.42443 of 2019 was filed which was got dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to avail any other remedy in accordance with law on 09.10.2019. The present petition has been filed just within 10 days of withdrawal of earlier petition.

[5]. Keeping in view the serious allegations in the FIR and in view of withdrawal of earlier petition on 09.10.2019, I see no reason to interfere in the present petition. The prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby declined and the petition is accordingly dismissed.
