Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was unlikely that the petitioner would have sold his land in the year 2013 in favour of the persons who had arraigned him as an accused in criminal proceedings in which he was acquitted in the year 2012. He further submits that the petitioner is still in possession of his land (as contended) and did not come to know that such a sale deed had been executed in the year 2013, thereby leading to a delay in filing a representation to the SSP.

Without making any comment whatsoever on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural (respondent no.4) to hear the petitioner, and to take action if any is warranted as per law, within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If the Sr. Superintendent of Police comes to the conclusion that actually no action by the police is called for, he would pass an order giving

reasons to that effect.
