On 19.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.432 dated 30.08.2019 registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(2) of SC & ST Act, at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 17.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-44094-2019 while granting interim protection to co-accused in the FIR in question.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 16.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer, who is present in Court, has submitted that the petitioners in this

case have joined the investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 19.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
