[1]. This appeal was filed through Mr. Harsh Bungar, Advocate. On 24.04.2018 and 25.07.2018, there was no representation on behalf of the appellant. On 17.10.2018, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant pleaded no instructions on the ground that office of the Advocate had returned the brief along with all instructions to the appellant. In the interest of justice, actual date notice was issued to the appellant for 16.01.2019.

[2]. On 16.01.2019, office reported that notice issued to the appellant could not be served as the appellant was not found residing on the given address. It was directed that the correct

address of the appellant be obtained from the office of the Advocate who had filed the appeal. Fresh notice was ordered to be issued for today.

[3]. Letter issued to the office of learned counsel for the appellant has been received back with a report that since the brief has been taken away by the appellant, therefore, no such information can be furnished.

[4]. Faced with this situation, this Court has no alternative, but to dismiss this appeal for want of prosecution.
