Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner, in FIR No.79 dated 17.07.2019, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

As per prosecution case, due to illicit relations of the petitioner with one Angrej Singh, husband of the petitioner, namely Kashmir Singh committed suicide by consuming some poisonous substance.

Contentends that the petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019 and after investigation in the matter, challan has already been submitted. Also contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official present in Court to assist him.

Heard both sides and perused the paper-book.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019, investigation in the matter is already and charges are yet to be framed; thus, the trial will take sufficient long time. Therefore, further incarceration of the petitioner would not serve any purpose.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, in this case, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

The petitioner shall fully co-operate with learned trial Court without seeking any unnecessary adjournments.
