Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.226 dated 07.10.2019 under Sections 346, 379, 506, 120-B IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners while referring the order passed in **CWP No.25406-2019 (Taslima and another Versus State of Haryana and others)** states that petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have solemnized marriage for which they have approached this Court for protection to their life and liberty, which was disposed of vide order dated 10.09.2019. He further states that petitioner No.1-Taslima @ Tasleema was earlier married to Mannaan, respondent No.2 and after divorce, she solemnized marriage with petitioner No.2-Javed Khan. He states that once petitioner No.1 has solemnized marriage with petitioner No.2 Javed Khan, there is no occasion for her to go with the earlier husband i.e. respondent No.2-Mannaan with whom her marriage has already been dissolved on the basis of divorce. He

further states that petitioner No.2 has submitted representation dated 08.10.2019 (Annexure P-7) to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh(Mewat), highlighting the aforesaid circumstances.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1.

Let a complete copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the Investigating Agency to look into the representation dated 08.10.2019 (Annexure P-7) submitted by petitioner No.2 and to act in accordance with law.

The petitioners are also at liberty to appear before the Superintendent of Police, Nuh(Mewat) to submit their grievances to which he shall take note of the same.
