Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.366 dated 02.06.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Model Town, Panipat, District Panipat.
