On 19.12.2018, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the State informs the Court that in the light of the fact that respondent No.4 is in unauthorized possession of the land, a show cause notice has been issued to him as to why he should not be removed from the post of Lambardar and 28.12.2018 is the date fixed for response/further proceedings. He, therefore, prays for an adjournment.

Adjourned to **08.02.2019**.

By the next date of hearing, final decision on the show cause notice be taken by the Competent Authority and the same be placed on record.”

In compliance of the order reproduced above, learned counsel

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for the State has produced a copy of order dated 29.01.2019 passed by the District Collector, Hisar, whereby, respondent No.4 – Madan Lal has been found to be in unauthorized possession of the land in Khasra No.132//16 to 25 of village Rampura and in pursuance thereto, order of dismissal of Madan Lal son of Mohar Singh from the post of Lambardar has been passed.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Shri Parkash Chand, Tehsildar, Hisar, submits that fresh process has been initiated for appointment to the post of Lambardar of village Rampura.

In view of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
