The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.166 dated 01.08.2018 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 22.10.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is alleged to have cheated the complainant by dishonestly adducing him to deliver an amount of ₹1,20,000/- on the pretext of getting him a job in the Army. The amount of ₹1,00,000/- had been paid through cheque on 27.06.2014 to Surjit Singh-father of the complainant and when the said amount was demanded, the present FIR was lodged by the complainant with a delay of about two years falsely implicating the petitioner. Notice of motion. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A Copy of the paper book along with enclosures has been supplied to the Learned State Counsel, who seeks time to complete his instructions.

Adjourned to 04.11.2019.”

Since the lawyers are abstaining from work today, there is no representation on behalf of either of the parties.

However, the Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 22.10.2019, has joined investigation and he is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 22.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
