MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has prayed for grant of interim bail under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2018 registered under Sections 22 and 61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana.

The prosecution case is that on 01.01.2018 during patrolling by police party, 700 grams heroin was recovered from the petitioner's possession.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that concession of interim bail for a period of three months was applied by the petitioner before the learned Sessions Court Ludhiana to make necessary arrangements for performing the marriage of his sister, Varinder Kaur, scheduled to be held on 25.11.2019. However, the trial Court allowed him to attend the wedding

on 25.11.2019 from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Learned Senior counsel submits that father of petitioner has already expired and being the only son, he has to look after certain arrangements and perform the rituals at the time of marriage of his sister. He further contends that the petitioner not being involved in any other case, therefore, the interim bail for a period of two weeks be granted.

Reply by way of affidavit of Waryam Singh PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police Central, Ludhiana on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Court today and taken on record.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Des Raj opposed the prayer. However, he does not dispute this fact that the marriage of sister of the petitioner is scheduled to take place on 25.11.2019 at Maharaja Resort, Verka Bye-Pass Road, Amritsar.

Considering the above, prayer of the applicant-petitioner is accepted and it is ordered that he be released on interim bail for a period of one week w.e.f. 21.11.2019 to 27.11.2019 subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court. It is made clear that the petitioner shall surrender himself before the Jail Authorities at Ludhiana on 27.11.2019 before 05.00 P.M.

The petition is allowed.
