Pursuant to the order dated 22.10.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in Court today an order passed by the learned Judge of the Special Court, Mohali, dated 2.11.2019, a perusal of which shows that pursuant to the aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioner has been admitted to bail to the satisfaction of that Court, upon him furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1.00 lakh with a surety in the like amount.

That being so, there would be no reason to not make the order dated 22.10.2019 absolute, but with it seen that seemingly inadvertently, I had not issued notice of motion to the State on that date.

Consequently, notice of motion is now issued, with Mr.B.S.Sewak, learned Addl.AG, Punjab, accepting notice at the asking of the Court.

before the learned trial Court and continues to satisfy all conditions imposed by that Court at the time of granting bail, the order dated 22.10.2019 is made absolute.
