The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 05.06.2019 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

The operative part of the order dated 23.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and his name surfaced during the investigation. It is further submitted that there is no attribution of any injury to the petitioner....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Savinder

Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
