The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the amount of CPF contribution made by the petitioner from 01.02.2009 to 30.04.2018.

2. Petitioner caused a legal notice dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-8) to the respondents, but the same has not been adverted by them. Hence, the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view

the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
