The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.247 dated 24.09.2019, registered under Sections 336/148/149 IPC and 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 22.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that though the petitioner was named in the FIR by the secret informer, the petitioner was not apprehended on the spot and there was no specific allegations against the petitioner...”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 22.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Chirmal Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
