The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 21 dated 08.02.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ('NDPS Act' - for short), registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted interim bail by the trial Court till the receipt of FSL report, but after the receipt of report of the FSL he had no knowledge that he was to surrender before the Court. The FSL report indicates that 40 vials of Onerex each containing 100 ml of orange colour liquid material (Codeine Phosphate) and 400 tablets of Carisoma containing Carisoprodol salt were recovered from a car which was being driven by the petitioner. He also contends that the Carisoma tablets are not covered under the NDPS Act. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. He further contends that the petitioner wants to surrender before the trial Court and shall

be preferring an application for bail and, therefore, he prays for withdrawal of this petition.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law.
