ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 121 dated 14.09.2019, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been registered by the wife of the deceased, are that the deceased was having illicit relations with the petitioner. It is also alleged that the petitioner had planted intoxicant tablets and tried to implicate her own son - Kamaljeet Singh in a false case.

This Court, by the order dated 22.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Gurbachan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
