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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 62 dated 17.08.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner. He also contends that there is a delay of two days in registering the FIR.

Heard.

It is manifest from the FIR that the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner, is a 'kirpan' blow on the forehead of the complainant. In view of the petitioner allegedly having caused an injury on the forehead of the complainant with a 'kirpan', I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
