On 24.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR
No.139 dated 20.9.2019 registered under Sections 308,
323 IPC read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station
Baghapurana, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that petitioner has also lodged a cross case as he also
suffered injuries. He further submits that petitioner is
alleged to be armed with a wooden batten and no specific
injury is attributed to have been caused by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna,
Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice
on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to

seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 13.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldhir Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 24.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
