The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 65 dated 20.07.2017 under Sections 302, 307, 324, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found innocent during investigation. He also contends that the 'challan' was submitted against seven accused, who are facing trial. He also contends that the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.'-for short). He also contends that the role, which is attributed to the petitioner in the FIR, is that he was armed with a 'datar' and had caused injury to injured Harpreet Singh. He further contends that Nirvail Singh

and Ranjeet Singh, who had also been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been granted interim bail by this Court.

This Court, by the order dated 08.11.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 13.11.2019 in terms of the order of this Court dated 08.11.2019 and had been granted interim bail. Copy of the trial Court order dated 13.11.2019 furnished by learned counsel for the petitioner has been taken on record.

In view of the above, the order dated 08.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date and shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
