Keeping in view the facts of the case and nature of the order
which this Court proposes to pass, this Court is of the view that the present
petition can be disposed of at this stage itself.

Petitioner is accused in FIR No.371 dated 25.11.2015
registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code
and under Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Sirsa,
District Sirsa. He was granted concession of bail. However, he absented on
21.09.2019 resulting in cancellation of bail and forfeiture of bail bonds and
surety bonds.

Now, learned trial Court issued warrants of arrest and fixed the

case for 05.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court on 05.11.2019 and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court. He submits that petitioner undertakes not to remain absent from any hearing of the case unless exemption in advance has been granted.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on the date already fixed and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

If the petitioner fulfills the undertaking, order cancelling his bail shall be deemed to have been set aside subject to payment of costs of ₹20,000/- to be deposited with Lawyer's Welfare Fund maintained by the local Bar Association as on 21.09.2019, one prosecution was present but due to absence of the petitioner, case had to be adjourned. Petitioner would also be required to file an undertaking in the form of affidavit as noticed above.
