This is a petition for grant of interim bail to the petitioner to enable him to attend the Bhog ceremony of his mother who has expired on 15.10.2019. The Bhog ceremony is stated to be fixed for 25.10.2019.

The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.186 dated 17.09.2018 under Sections 21 & 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City, District Roop Nagar.

The allegations against the petitioner are that 520 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride was recovered from him. The investigation in this case is complete and the trial has commenced.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioner be released on interim bail to enable him to attend the Bhog ceremony and other rituals in connection with death of his mother. He states that the petitioner is the only son of his parents. His father had also died some time back.

The factum of death of the mother of the petitioner has been

got verified by the ASI Angrej Singh, Police Station City, Roop Nagar, District Roop Nagar. He has also verified that the Bhog ceremony of mother of the petitioner is fixed for 25.10.2019. The verification report filed in court today, is taken on record.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail from 23.10.2019 to 31.10.2019 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty magistrate. He would surrender before the jail authority on 31.12.2019 before 5.00 pm.

Petition stands disposed of.
