Learned counsel for the appellant submits that a circular dated 11.09.2019, attached with CM-16275-C-2019, has been issued by the Chief Engineer/Commercial, UHBVN, Panchkula, wherein a Surcharge Waiver Scheme, 2019 for all the consumers has been introduced. It is mentioned in the Scheme that 100% delayed payment surcharge amount shall be waived off on payment of outstanding principal amount in lump-sum. It is further provided that the Scheme shall be available to all those AP consumers who agree to withdraw their court cases from the Court, pertaining to their tubewell connections. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of this Surcharge Waiver Scheme, 2019, the appellant wishes to settle the matter with the Department and he seeks to withdraw this appeal.

Learned counsel for the respondents affirms and verifies the floating of the above said Scheme and submits that the Department has no objection to consideration of the appellant's case under the said Scheme in case he withdraws this appeal.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above and the specific stand of the parties, the application is disposed of and this appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the appellant to approach the respondents for consideration under the Surcharge Waiver Scheme, 2019.
