Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against accused persons mentioned in FIR No.101 dated 11.06.2019 registered under Sections 341 and 506 read with Section 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Lambi, District Shri Muktsar Sahib and present the challan.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to reveal the status of bail of the accused persons.

Considering the nature of offence and the fact that the FIR was recently registered, this Court does not find any valid reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
