The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 126 dated 01.06.2019, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 23.10.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Thamman Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
