This criminal revision is directed against order dated 07.09.2019 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Bathinda in CRA No.218 of 2018, whereby the appeal preferred against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 19.3.2018 of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul convicting him for the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 in complaint No. COMA/22/2017 has been dismissed.

The complaint was instituted by respondent No.2 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, wherein the petitioner was sentenced to undergo imprisonment for 01 year and 06 months, in addition to fine. His appeal has been dismissed as stated above.

In view of above, this criminal revision is disposed of. The conviction of the petitioner is maintained. However, his sentence is reduced to that already undergone by him.

The petitioner is in custody. He is ordered to be released forthwith if he is not wanted in any other case.
