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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 read with Section 437 (6) Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 203, dated 14.6.2018, registered under Sections 392, 365, 170, 419, 420, 34 IPC and under Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Division No. 5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 20.6.2018. The charges were framed on 13.10.2018. However, trial has made no headway. Even no witness has been examined till date. The offences are triable by the Court of learned Magistrate. So no purpose would be served by keeping petitioner behind bars and he be released on bail.

The learned State counsel, while opposing bail application of petitioner, on instructions from ASI Tarlochan Singh, states that there are serious allegations against petitioner.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for parties and the fact that petitioner is in custody since 20.6.2018 and also the fact that charges against petitioner have been framed on 13.10.2018 and the fact that no witness has been examined till date and that the trial has made no headway, no purpose would be served by keeping petitioner behind the bars.

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Resultantly, petition is allowed and petitioner namely Gursharan Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
