On 24.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 20.07.2019 registered under Sections 365, 328, 342, 384, 506, 120-B, 386 of the Indian Penal Code (Offences under Sections 380, 457 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties at some length, it is considered appropriate to direct the petitioner to join investigation.

Adjourned to 13.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction

of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harjinder Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 24.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
