The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 15.01.2016 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner and for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the letter/order dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-10).

2. Petitioner submitted a representation dated 15.01.2016 (Annexure P-6) but the same have not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts the notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Given the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity

to seek return by any of the respondents, as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required in the present case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 15.01.2016 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the averments and contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
