The prayer made in this petition is basically for seeking compensation for the alleged loss caused to the petitioners at the hands of the respondents. In view thereof, the only remedy available to the petitioners is filing of a civil suit for compensation in accordance with law but insofar as this petition is concerned, it is not maintainable because for the purpose of determining the amount of compensation, the parties have to lead their respective evidence to establish the factum of suffering the loss and its extent thereof.

Faced with these observations, counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to file a civil suit in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
Liberty granted.
