The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 06.07.2019 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

The operative part of the order dated 23.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, five police officials stopped a car and thereafter, driver of the same ran away from the spot. It is further submitted that recovery of 156 bottles of liquor, meant for sale in Haryana, has already been effected and the petitioner is sought to be arrested on the ground that he is registered owner of the car....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
