Prayer in present writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.3 and 4 to take effective steps to clean the village pond so that waste water may not cause the loss to the crops of petitioner every year.

Mr. Balbir Singh Jaswal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the request/representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-9) within some specified time.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without going into merit of case or commenting thereon, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the request/representation dated 13.02.2019 (Annexure P-9) by passing a well

reasoned and speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, request/representation is not decided within
aforementioned specified time, there shall be costs of Rs.25,000/- to be paid
by the concerned officer to the petitioner.
