Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 227 dated 5.10.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner has defrauded first informant of Rs.8,50,000/-. The Court of Sessions while dismissing the pre-arrest bail application has noted that an agreement dated 9.4.2019 was executed by the petitioner agreeing to return the amount of Rs.8,50,000/- alongwith interest at the rate of 4 % per month, which has also not been paid.

Keeping in view the fact of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.
