The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of on the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the representation is looked into. With the reply, compliance report dated 16.3.2019 is attached, wherein it has been stated that traffic checking was conducted to check route violations and the vehicles which were found to be plying without documents were challaned.
