Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 347 dated 24.07.2019 registered under Sections 21-B, 22-C and 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that alleged recovery were of 60 strips of psychotropic substance i.e. 50 strips (containing 10 tablets each) of Tramadol Cavilodol-100 SR and 10 strips of Tramadol Trio-SR (containing 10 tablets each), which are slightly excess of the commercial quantity and the petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2019.

On the instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, learned State counsel states that that out of 13 witnesses, none has been examined till date.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2019 and the trial would take the sufficient time for conclusion.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
