On 24.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.28 dated 1.5.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 120-B and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC added lateron at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is alleged to have exhorted other accused and no specific injury is alleged to have been caused by the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is an old man of 67 years.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned

counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 6.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balraj Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 24.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
