By this order, two petitions bearing CRM-M-45528-2019 and CRM-M-45549-2019, shall stand disposed of.

On 24.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“This order will be read in two petitions bearing CRM-M45528 and CRM-M-45549 of 2019.*

*Petitioner (in both petitions) who are employees of Punjab National Bank pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 6 dated 5.2.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib.*

*Apart from other contentions, learned counsel for the*

*petitioners relies on order dated 1.10.2019 passed by this Court in CRMM-21831-2019 with respect to a co-accused.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Sh. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Sr. DAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.*

*Adjourned to 13.11.2019.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner (in both petitions) shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner (in both petitions) shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

*A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.”*

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Gurbachan Singh, has submitted that the petitioners in both the cases have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

Hence, order dated 24.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
