Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court including his pleas to the effect that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case by the complainant simply in order to settle scores and to pressurize her husband with whom she was having matrimonial discord.

The learned counsel has further submitted that in fact falsity of the FIR would be evident from the fact that the petitioners are residing separately from the complainant or her husband and while petitioner No.1 happens to be sister of the complainant's husband; petitioner No.2 is husband of petitioner No.1; petitioner No.3 is maternal aunt of complainant's husband and petitioner No.4 is maternal uncle of complainant's husband, who have all been roped in simply to pressurize the entire family.

In view of aforesaid submission for withdrawal of petition, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to raise all the pleas raised herein before the Trial Court at appropriate stage.

Since it has been informed that the matter is fixed before the Trial Court to consider framing of charges, the Trial Court shall meticulously examine all the pleas in context of the evidence collected by the police during the course of investigation.
