The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 13 dated 29.03.2018, under Sections 379-B, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that a .32 bore revolver and an amount of ₹7000-8000 were snatched from the pocket of the complainant. He also contends that the revolver has been recovered from co-accused Sandeep Singh while recovery of arms licence has been effected from co-accused Paramjit Singh. He also contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused Sandeep Singh. He further contends that there is no *prima facie* evidence which would connect the petitioner with the alleged commission of offence.

This Court, by order dated 24.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Surjeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 24.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
